The dates above each column are the dates by which the result of the previous games should be played by.

In the first round it is the responsibility of the first named to make contact and arrange a convenient date for the game. DO NOT however wait forever, as your opponent may have been trying and you were not in. Please report your problems to the Competition Secretary well before the end of the round asking for assistance. I have allowed 6 weeks in most cases and seven in some for the first round to be played. This should be plenty of time if you get on with making arrangements.

After the game it is the winner's responsibility to ring the result through to the Competition Secretary, preferably before 10pm. If both results are known he will be able to tell one or other who their next opponent is. It will then be their responsibility to arrange the next game even if it's on their opponents green. Substitutes WILL BE USED if difficulties arise in arranging because players are not available through holiday or illness. The only acceptable excuse would be for County Competitions, when with the agreement of the Competition Secretary an extension will be allowed. If no agreement can be found then the Competition Secretary will mediate and allocate a date for that game to be played. His decision will be final and binding on both parties.

FINALS

All Semi-Finals and Finals will be played at South Wigston with the Semi-finals in the week commencing 16th July 2024 and the Finals in the week commencing 22nd July, after consultation with the players involved.
